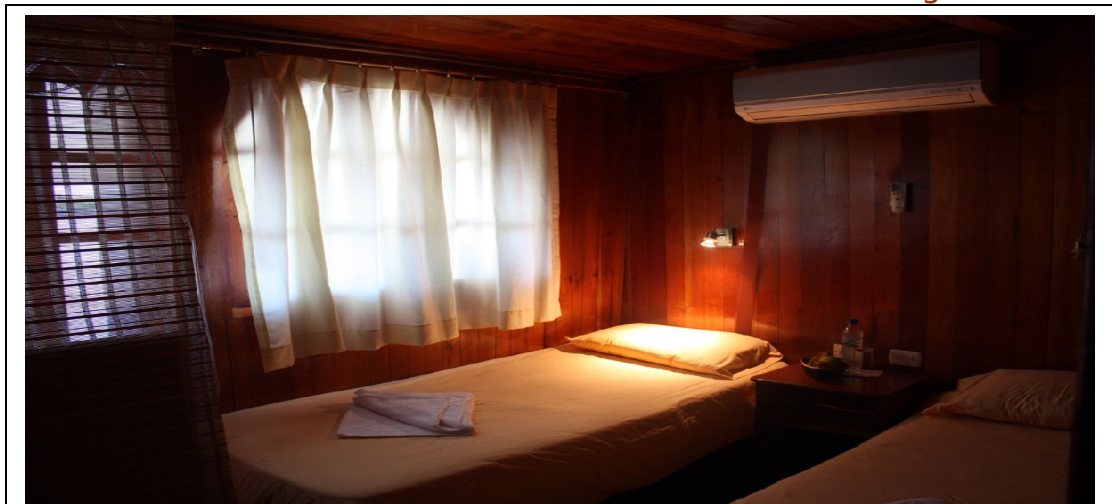
Tourist Amazon Cruise



Jungle Discovery is a Tourist Class Cruise which is operating out of Iquitos in the Pacaya Samiria.

Cabins:

Their 15 cabins are paneled in wood and have their private bathrooms with hot and cold water in the shower and air conditioning.



There are:

6 Junior Suites: These small suites have a average size of 95 and 104 square feet. All of them have a queen size bed of 54"x79" and small desk with a chair.

8 Double Cabins: These cabins have a average size of 68 square feet and two single beds of 27" x 79".

1 Single Cabin: This cabin has a size of 42 square feet and a single bed of 27"x 79"

Dining Room:

The dining room on the Main Deck measure 26,8 ft x 15,3ft, is paneled in wood and has a social toilet. The Dining Room has Air conditioning as well.

Bar and covered Sun deck

The covered Sun Deck measure 480 square feet. On the side are rolled up transparent plastic curtains which can get closed in rainy weather. The bartender offers for sale a variety of drinks, beer, wine and snacks to the guests.

Expedition Cruise to Pacaya Samiria National Reserve:

Pacaya-Samiria National Reserve is one of the biggest protected areas located in Peru's Amazon region, 200 miles west from Iquitos. The Reserve is a triangular shaped area between the Marañon and Ucayali rivers. These rivers intersect at the northeastern tip of the Reserve, marking the beginning of what is considered the Amazon River proper.

A diverse animal wildlife and more than 300 species of birds live in Pacaya-Samiria, including five of the eight species of Macaw found in Peru.



Expedition to Tabatinga It is located in the [Brazilian state of Amazonas](#). Together with the neighboring [Colombian](#) city of [Leticia](#) and the [Peruvian](#) city of [Santa Rosa de Yavari](#), The first Portuguese settlement in the area was founded in the 18th century.

Expedition to Leticia is a small town of approximately 37,000 inhabitants situated on the left bank of the Amazon River. It is the capital of the state of Amazonas, Colombia's southernmost town
