The Selva Viva has 6 spacious and luminous cabins (4 matrimonial/double cabins and 2 individual cabins), decorated with care, provided with shutters and mosquito nets on the window to assure the privacy and the tranquility of the passengers. Every cabin is provided by various 220V plugs.

The Selva Viva provides a terrace of more than 160m² (1720 feet²) on its upper deck.

It is equipped by hammocks and a large table at disposal, especially for the lunches. Its elevated position makes an exceptional watchtower to observe the jungle's biodiversity, and the perfect place to relax.

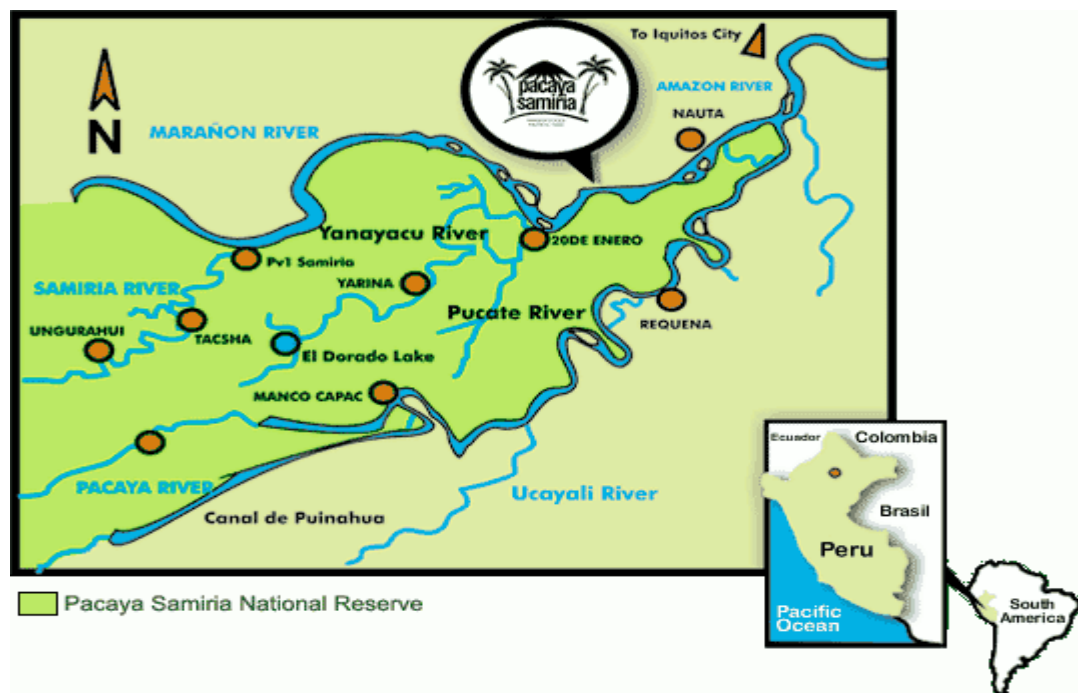
Moreover, it has all the security elements necessary: GPS, sounder, HF Radio (500kms range) and 9 fire extinguishers aboard and 2 fire hose nozzle.

The Selva Viva's crew is made up of 6 permanent members, each one specialist in their domain. Everyone has his "navigation carnet", delivered by the Peruvian Marine. All cruises long will be accompanied by Serge Lopez, the French cruise director.

Expedition Cruise to Pacaya Samiria National Reserve:

Pacaya-Samiria National Reserve is one of the biggest protected areas located in Peru's Amazon region, 200 miles west from Iquitos. The Reserve is a triangular shaped area between the Marañon and Ucayali rivers. These rivers intersect at the northeastern tip of the Reserve, marking the beginning of what is considered the Amazon River proper.

A diverse animal wildlife and more than 300 species of birds live in Pacaya-Samiria, including five of the eight species of Macaw found in Peru.



Expedition to Allpahuayo Reserve

The Allpahuayo-Mishana National Reserve, created on January 16, 2008 - was a reserved area from 1999- by the Peruvian government, encompasses 142, 272 hectares of land approximately. This National Reserve contains 500 varieties of trees per 2.5 acres, more than any site on earth and nearly 100 plant species which do not exist anywhere else in the world. The flora of the reserve is diverse with over 1,900 species. This rain forest is composed of several soil types, ranging from rare white quartz sands to red clays. Each of these soil types supports a unique community of plants and animals, making the Allpahuayo-Mishana National Reserve one of the most biodiversity areas in the world.
